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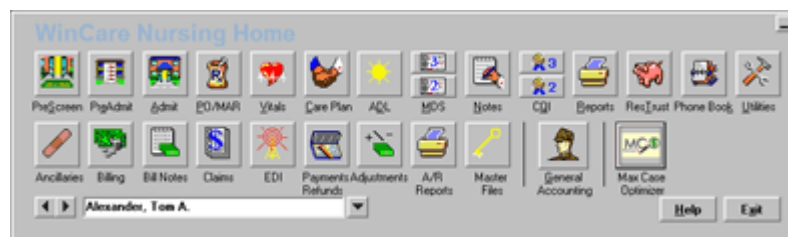
CHAPTER 1

Clinical

Use this book in conjunction with the downloaded trial version of WinCare to view key features and sample screenshots. Each module opens with one click of the mouse from the Clinical Control Panel as displayed below.

In addition to the modules, the Resident List and Help button are accessed from the control panel. The Help button displays a menu which includes a user guide for all clinical, integrated (billing), add-on modules, system requirements, and release notes.

Clinical Control Panel:



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Pre-Admit

This module is designed to set up a resident's admission prior to a physical admission.

KEY FEATURES:

- Module may be used as a resident waiting list
- Available PO/MAR functions
- Policy forms can be printed blank or with resident data
- Ability to print individual or summary reports

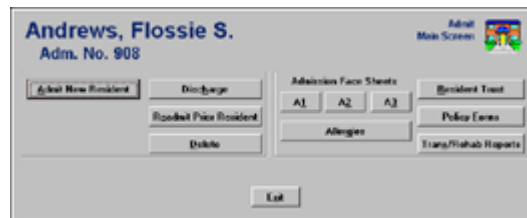

Admit

The Admit module enables the user to admit and discharge residents, enter face sheet data, track resident's personal money, note allergies, etc.

KEY FEATURES:

- Record resident-specific demographic data (face sheets) including allergies
- Record admission/discharge/readmission resident data
- Generate and Print Patient Transfer notices
- Track resident's personal money

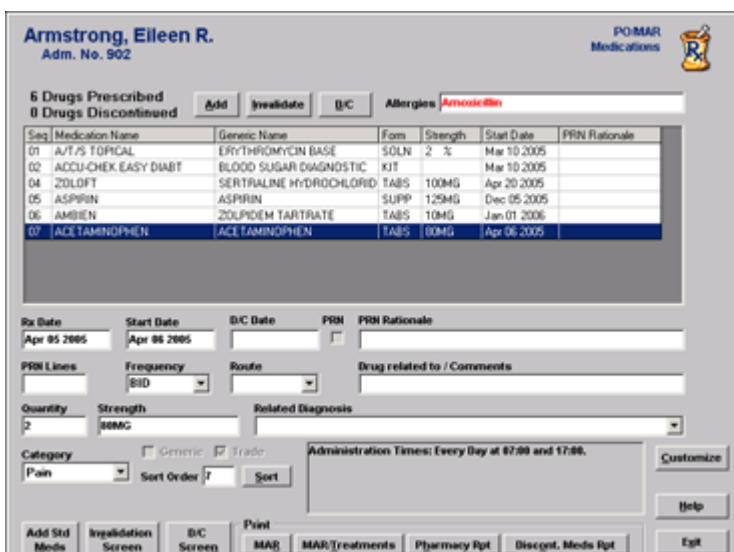


PO/MAR

The PO/MAR contains specific sections in which to enter medications, treatments, dietary, therapy notes, etc.

KEY FEATURES:

- EMR-Real Time MAR (Add-On module)
- Ability to enter customized drugs to the database
- Track specific items (ex. catheters, restraints, etc.)
- Record and track immunizations
- Diabetic flow sheet
- Allergy alerts
- Behavior Monitoring (Add-On module)




Vitals

This module tracks a resident's vital information.

KEY FEATURES:

- Flows to MDS assessments
- Significant weight change alert
- Automatically calculate BMI from height and weight
- Track trends of the resident's condition

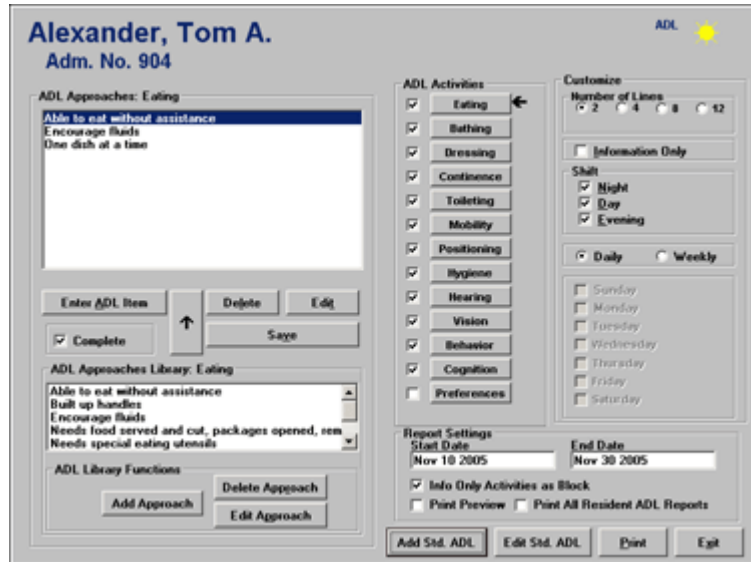

- Customizable ADL library

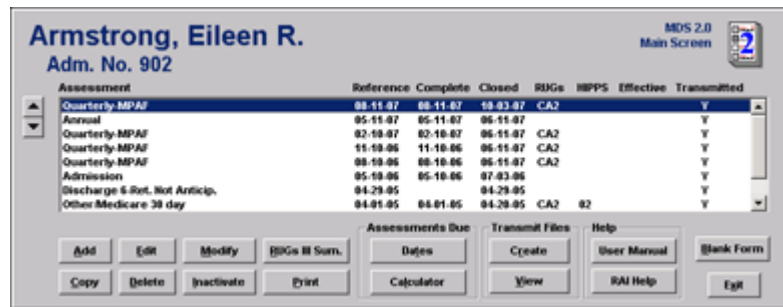


MDS

- Print an individual or all stored notes



CQI

The CQI module enables the user to produce reports and graphs to display the current residents' conditions or status.

KEY FEATURES:

- F-Tag report
- Replicate reports
- QI Crosswalk-generated report to reflect current census
- Acuity Monitoring - snapshot of facility population
- Pressure Sore Risk and Fall Risk assessments (Add-On modules)

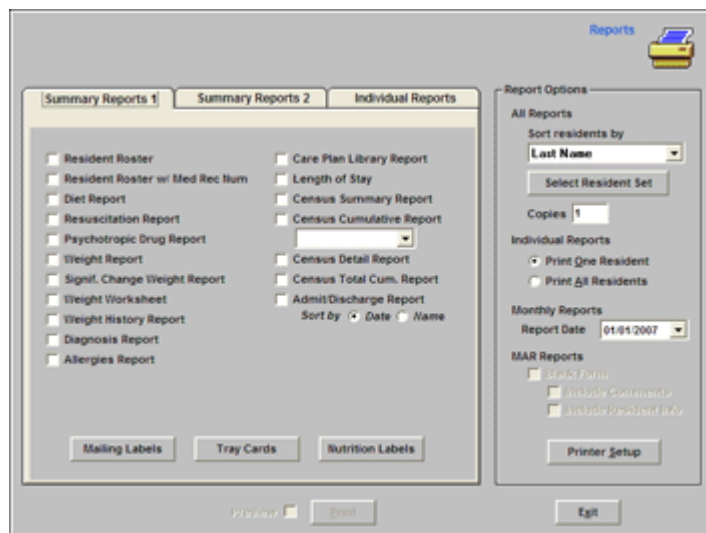
