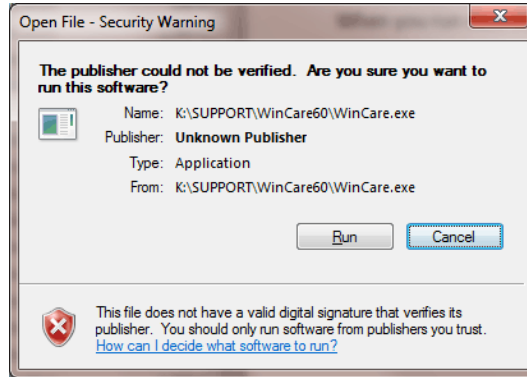

When you run exes from a network drive (Intranet) you can may get this message every time, if you do then these steps should resolve this problem.

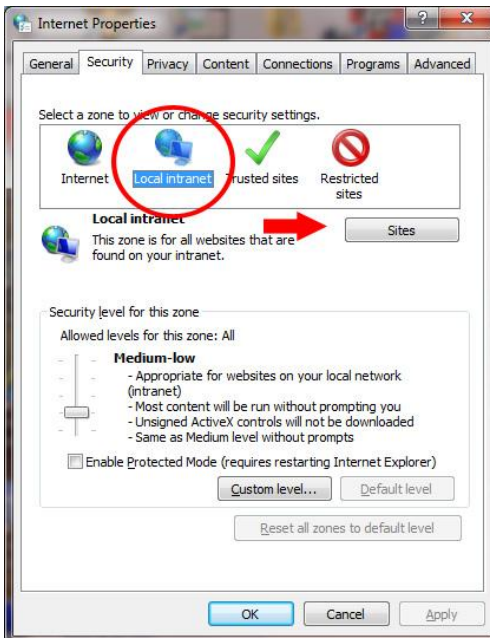


You can tell Windows that programs on your Intranet server are safe by following these steps. (The Example is using Windows 7)

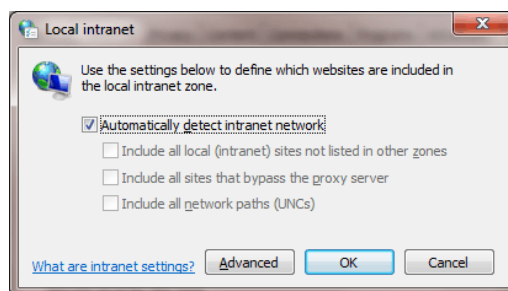
1) Go into "Internet Options". To get into Internet Options use one of these steps:

- a. Click "Start" or press the Windows button, in the search field start typing "Internet Options" when it shows in the list above click on it.
- b. Click "Start" or press the Windows button, click "Control Panel", then "System and Security", on the left click "Network and Internet", then click "Internet Options".
- c. Start Internet Explorer, press the "Alt" key then click "Tools" and then "Internet Options"

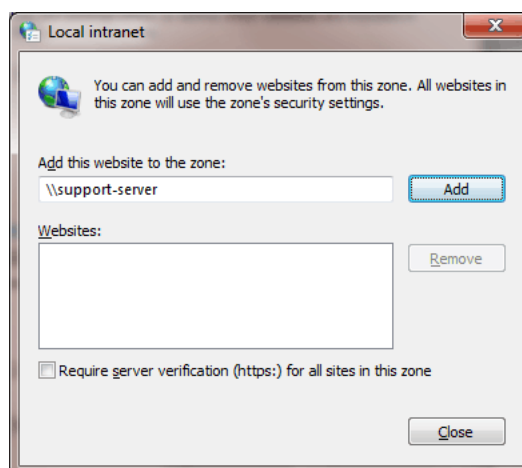
2) Click the "Security" tab. At the top of the screen click on "Local intranet", then click "Sites"



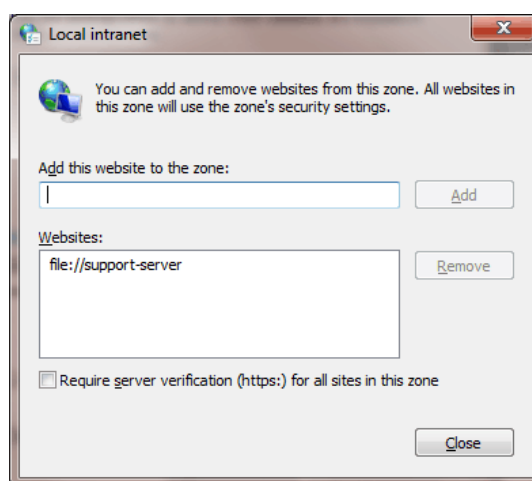
3) Now click "Advanced"



4) Under "Add this website to the zone:" type in the UNC path to the local server.



5) Then click "Add" and then "Close".



6) Exit out of Internet Options and run your application, the message should be gone now.
